As reported in a previous Messenger, we are soon going to covenant with **Dr**. **Krista Givens** who is a pastor in Hamburg,
Germany. When we covenant with a missionary, we pledge to sponsor them with a dollar amount (in this case \$2,500) for a year (or more). This way, the church will be able to anticipate the income for a particular missionary. You can check out her missionary biography on-line.

She is from Southern California, so our hope is that we will be able to see her from time to time. Her biography includes: "Growing up outside of mainstream religion, Krista longed to find a spiritual location, a place to find God, community and herself. After searching various Christian denominations and other faith traditions, she joined the Claremont United Methodist Church community in 1992. Amid a congregation of



current and former professors, retired pastors and business professionals, Dr. Givens was influenced by former missionaries in the congregation.

"Each of us has a role to play in God's work and my place is with the children of the world. When I was called into ministry in 1998, I understood that call to be one to "hands-on" ministry – a ministry in which I would need to risk my self for the sake of the gospel,"
