Young Adult Sunday School (College Age – 40), 12:00-12:30PM in Room 5

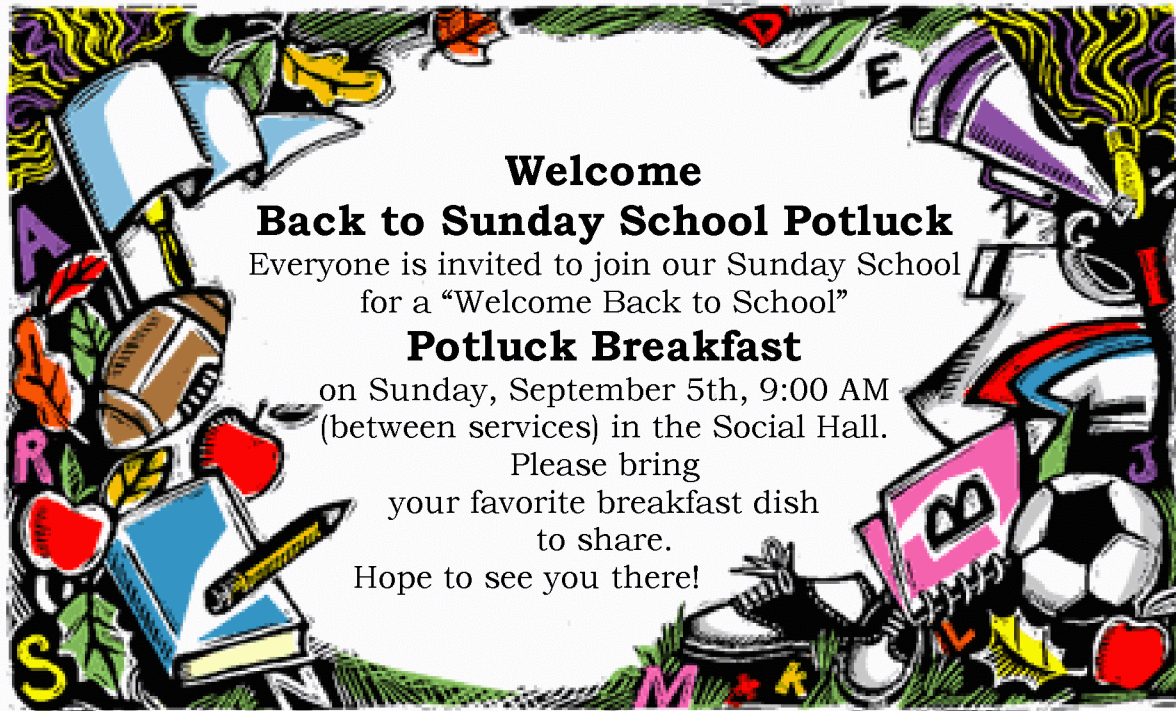
